## THE JAPANESE FEDERATION OF KENDO OFFERS EQUIPMENT TO AKIMO

The hand-over ceremony of the equipment donated to AKIMO by the Japanese Federation of Kendo took place on April 17, in presence of the Deputy Minister of Youth and Sports, Carlos Sousa, the Ambassador of Japan in Mozambique, Eiji Hashimoto, the Director of the Japanese International Cooperation Agency (JICA), Ryuichi Nasu and the Sensei Masao Suenaga.

The Kendo and laido Association of Mozambique (AKIMO) received this donation directly from the Japanese Federation of Kendo through the Embassy of Japan in Mozambique.

The AKIMO was founded in 2004, with the influence of the former Ambassador of Japan. Kanii Tsushima, and since then is dedicated to the disclosure of Kendo and laido practices. It is regularly taking part in international seminars and graduations. A major milestone was achieved early 2012: the first graduation held in Mozambigue in the Naval Club.

AKIMO's vision is ambitious, consisting in disseminating and popularizing the practice of Kendo and Iaido in the whole country,

specifically in schools including these sports in their curricula as it is already a reality in the American International School of Mozambigue (AISM) and will soon be one in Francisco Manyanga School. On top of that, the AKIMO is focused on creating a national team to represent Kendo in Mozambique in international competitions, especially in the kendo world championships which take place every three years.

The AKIMO vividly thanks the Embassy of Japan for its unconditional support and JICA for bringing Sensei Suenaga (7th Dan) who is being essential in raising the quality of kendo in the country and the leadership in the national team organisation.
