SPORT FISHING

The Summer Trophy fishing competition will be held on December 15. "This first and only competition of the year will be a test of our ability to organize a major event, a two-day international fishing competition, scheduled on February 16 and 17, 2013, as part of the celebrations of the Club's Centenary."

To take part in the Summer Trophy fishing competition, you shall register from December 1 to 14, at the Naval Club Secretary. The cost is 500 meticals per fisherman.

Each boat must have a minimum crew of two people and the maximum will be dictated by the capacity of the boat described in the registration document.

Regulation of the competition is available at the Naval Club Secretary.

This year, the rules are a little different, with a new scoring model.

The competition will have two divisions - Bill Fish and Game Fish - but in terms of scores, these divisions are independent, ie the points of each division will not count against the other division. Thus, different boats may win each of the divisions, and one boat may win both divisions.

We hope a lot of participation from the Naval Club fishermen!



Note also that the revision of the Rules of Recreational and Sport Fishing, Decree 51/99 of 31 August is currently being discussed.

The key points of this review are:

- Revision of all fishing fees,
- Restriction of capture,
- Increased communication and collaboration of nautical clubs with the Ministry of Fisheries for better monitoring of catches. It should be noted that from the 1st of November, the Naval Club has been collecting information on catches, so every boat that arrives at the Club must declare its catches.
