## LAST ACHIEVEMENTS PRESENTED BY VICTOR SERRAVENTOSO

### What are the latest achievements of the Board?

"Lately, we organized the following points to improve the operation of the Clube Naval.

- **Water tanks:** two weeks ago we installed two water deposits of 1,500 liters each, connected to a water pump which allows to have enough pressure and constant power to wash boats and fishing equipment even during the afternoon. In the last ten years, the Clube Naval was dependent on municipal grid regarding the washing of boats and other fishing materials. This implied that this service could only be executed in the morning until 11.00am. It was impossible to wash boats in the afternoon period.

- **Parking:** due to congestion of cars in the Clube, we established a new rule in order to better organize the space allowing boats to freely access the ramp. The big change is that now only one vehicle per boathouse is allowed to enter at the same time. This new rule came into force on 15th of September and already produces beneficial effects.

- **Works:** after the last General Assembly, a public tender was launched and the space of the first floor was recently awarded to the company Luna, Ida. The works to transform the space into a snack-bar are in progress. The opening is scheduled for mid-November. Regarding the space of the 1st floor, a public tender was released. The board along with a committee made up by some members is strictly analyzing the 4 proposals. This space will be awarded very soon."
