- 'My father' ... "The son of a fisherman knows how to fish."
- · How have you been interested in fishing?
- "I saw some friends fishing here at Clube Naval, so I started to fish as well."
- What was your first fish?
- 'A 2 kg xaréu '
- · And today, how was the fishing?
- "I was able to catch three 3-4 kg fish."

Jose Rosado, better known by his nickname of Zé Pescador, is a member of the Clube Marítimo de Desportos. He teamed with Ricardo Duarte for this competition.

- · What did you fish?
- 'Nine tunas, one serra, one grouper, two barracudas and two bogus.'
- And what is your technique?
- 'We use two: trolling and jigging.'
- · In which area did you fish?
- "Between the Poço and the Lacerda lighthouse."
- · Zé Pescador, who gave you that nickname?
- "It was given to me at the Clube Naval, since I was little. At that time, I was always fishing on the wall. We caught large fish, for example, I've fished a 190 kg shark... I have also done spearfishing since I was kid, that's why they have given me this nickname.'

Alexandre Pais

A member of the Naval Club since 1996. I'm fishing since I was 6 year old.

- · How did you learn to fish?
- 'I learned with my father, at river Umbeluzi in Marracuene and Macaneta. Then I started to fish in the high seas with friends.'
- · How was the fishing today?
- 'Today, I caught one blue marlin of 165 kg. We fought 1h30, I wanted to release it but the fish died. We always try to make the release of the fish.'
- And where did you find this trophy?
- 'Next to Inhaca in a 300 meter deep zone.'
- And the team?
- 'The team caught a strip Marlin of 80kg, and we did the release.'
- · What is the technique that you used?
- 'The trolling. The boat is sailing at a speed of 13 km per hour or 6 knots, we put canes and fake bait (squid) on the surface.'
