Louis, how did Global Alliance get the idea to organize a Fishermen Dhow Race?

- "We wanted to do something different, something for the community and for our clients. In 2006, while having lunch at Clube Naval, seeing the dhows sailing on the sea, we decided to organize this race. The race gives a good opportunity to fishermen to win substantial prizes, allowing them to invest in things that improve their lives and it is also a good way to gather and thank our clients. Our clients come in the afternoon at the headquarters, watch the race, assist to the prizes ceremony and then enjoy some entertainment. All this event is organized with local companies and mozambican food and beverage."

· How will be the Dhow Race this year?

- "It will be the 8th Edition of the Dhow Race, it will take place on 26th of April. We organize this race with the strong technical support of Clube Naval since 2006, this is a very good partnership. The dhow race will gather 100 fishing dhows - 3 fishermen per dhow - racing from Xefina Island to Global Alliance headquarters on the Avenida Marginal in Maputo."

· What about the prizes?

- "The first dhow arriving at Global Alliance headquarters will receive a 10 000 USD prize, the second one will receive 5 000 USD and then the third 2 500 USD. Each participant also receives a food parcel, the idea being not to lose a fishing day."

Focusing on insurance, your core business, are you also working with boats?

- "Yes, we do. We offer comprehensive insurance with liability cover for most types of boats. Of course there are terms and conditions, but generally we charge between 2,5% to 5% of the boat value per year. For boats of 10 years and plus, we do a survey."
